

Salisbury FCSC Committee AGM 09 Oct 2021 Start 17:28 at Ray Mac Stadium.

Minutes of the last AGM (5th June 2019) were read.

There had not been an AGM in 2020 due to Covid closures.

Benefit Race Night for Jake went very well and the minibus that season went well too.

2020 – 2021 Season: Good start to this season. One Race Night was held and made £520.

Covid Draw: *All the 3's* was successful. Made £570 which was shared between SFC and Salisbury District Hospital.

Due to the previous season being truncated by Covid 19, membership this year has been rolled over without further charge. Lots of people have either donated their £5 membership or bought £5 worth of 50/50s draw tickets.

This season so far, we have managed to donate £3,500 to SFC bringing the total figure of donation since we reformed in 2015 to £67,500 which is an amazing amount of money raised from the fans and the Supporters' Club.

We also made a £135 donation towards other causes. £25 went in memory of Alec Hayter.

£110 was donated to the Sarum Graphics commercial board due to them very kindly printing our 50/50 tickets for free.

Alan Green has expressed appreciation to Supporters' Club for all the help they do for Salisbury Football Club and around the stadium. He also thanked some of the members of the Committee who regularly go up to the Ray Mac during the week helping out with any maintenance work that needs attention.

Recently Alan has become the President of the Supporters' Club - Alan has been involved with the club for 45years in one way or another. He is going to liaise with the Club for supporters.

Committee Elections: The committee agreed to re-stand again en masse. No objections.

A new member, Emma Carey, was proposed by Ray Neal and seconded by Bev Ellis and others. Emma has agreed to officially join the Committee after attending two meetings previous to the AGM. Emma is a very keen supporter and will be an asset to the Committee.

Ray Neal proposed Amanda Newbury to join the committee after speaking to her about it and she is very interested in doing so. This was second by multiple people at the AGM.

Coaches / Minibus. This year we are struggling to fill a minibus so unless there is a huge interest for a coach we will not be running one as it makes a loss. We hope to run the minibus to away games which costs £140 a time, so needs at least ten people to cover the costs.

Chairman of the Supporters' Club committee also expressed his appreciation to the Committee Members individually for all their hard work and also thanked the non-committee volunteers who always help out where they can. Thank you all.
